Star of the North Skating Club has been serving youth of the Grand Rapids area for over 25 years. We are a non-profit organization that teaches skaters from age 3 years old to adult. We teach all levels from Tiny Tots up to the highest United States Figure Skating Association levels.

We offer many types of lessons. For example:

**Tiny Tots Class** is for girls & boys aged 3-4 years old. We coach them in how to skate forwards and backwards, and how to get up when they fall. We play games on the ice like Duck, Duck, Goose (which teaches them how to stand up once they have fallen), Red Light, Green Light (which works on stopping and going), and the bean bag toss (which takes their mind off of being afraid to let go and try to skate by them selves).

**Learn 2 Skate / Hockey Class** is for girls & boys of all ages. We work with them on improving their skating skills. They work on forward & backwards skating, hockey stops, and hockey edges. The main purpose of this class is to make our area hockey players stronger skaters.

**Parent and Me Class** is for our young beginner skaters. Parents skate with their child to help with instruction.

**Basic Skills Group Lessons** is a class for all ages that want to learn figure skating moves. We teach the fundamentals of figure skating. This class teaches skaters how to work together in a group, as well as work on their individual skills. At this level there are Basic Skills Competitions throughout Minnesota where skaters can show compete in various categories.

**Pre-Freeskate/Freeskate** is a group setting class for the higher basic skill levels.

**Private Lessons** offer the more serious skaters the chance to have a one to one lesson with a coach. These skaters work on Moves in the Field and Freeskate levels. Skaters at the higher levels can compete regionally with freeskate, compulsory and artistic routines.

**Junior Instructor** Once skaters have passed their first 4 USFSA Tests and are 13 years old they can become Jr Instructors. These Skaters are training to become coaches. Junior instructors learn how to work with different ages and skill levels. It teaches them how to be a leader, and the importance of giving back to their community.

## **What does your sponsorship money pay for?**

Your sponsorship money will go to help cover our ice fees at the IRA Civic Center, ice show costumes and decorations. All money collected goes to the skaters as we are a non-profit. Our Club is run by our parent volunteers, and is overseen by a governing board. We have learned to be very frugal and efficient with our budget and are committed to keeping the club in the Grand Rapids area. Our coaches are all skaters who have skated with the Star of the North Skating Club; we have gone through the program and Junior Instructed. We love our skaters and our Skating Club.
